Located at the Pike Place Market-adjacent State Hotel, the playful Ben Paris features creations by recent New Orleans transplant Abigail Gullo. The cocktail list reads like a storybook, where ingredients are woven alongside tall tale tidbits. The Manhattan-esque Longshoreman is based on a true story, though: It's a tribute to Gullo's grandfather, from whom she learned to make her first cocktail ... when she was seven.
